Covid Protocols (rev. 3 10/19/2022)

Covid protocols apply to ALL individuals, including but not limited to coaches, participants and spectators (ie. players, parents, siblings) coming to the ESGVJCC facility.

- Must be fully vaccinated* (proof required) or if not fully vaccinated, provide proof of a negative Covid-19 test (approved home test is OK) at least 24 hours prior to attending a game
- Masking IS required at the ESGVJCC facility (incl. gym and courtyard area)
- Proof of vaccination and/or negative Covid-19 test results should be submitted to your Team Representative PRIOR to arriving at ESGVJCC facility
- Gym will be sanitized after each game. The League Director will ask everyone to exit the gym, sanitizing the gym takes approx. 10 mins. The next scheduled game will begin as soon as this process has been completed and LD allows the next teams inside.

Team Reps – Please collect your teams proof of vaccination and/or negative Covid-19 test results and submit results to Shauna Hiranaka at (909) 851-4944 or ShaunaHiranaka@gmail.com

- Submit a list of your team (ie. Players, coaches, etc...) and indicate whether they are fully vaccinated or negative Covid-19 test result
- This list should also include all individuals associated with your team (ie. Parents, Siblings, spectators, etc...) that plan to attend a game
- If unable to submit in advance, proof can be sent directly to Shauna for tracking purposes
- Covid-19 test must be done weekly if not fully vaccinated

Shauna will maintain a list of those who submitted proof of being fully vaccinated.

FAQ

Q: Are you limiting the number of spectators inside the facility?

A: *Yes, only a limited number of spectators will be allowed; in addition to any rostered player and coaches; 10 spectators (chairs provided) per team will be allowed. Courtyard – 4 spectators allowed. Additional waiting area will be available outside the courtyard in a section of the parking lot.*

Q: Can I take a Covid-19 home test?

A: *Yes, Covid-19 approved home test results are accepted at least 24 hours prior to your game. Submit results to your Team Representative.*

Q: Do you provide testing if I do not have a Covid-19 home test available or can not find one?

A: *ESGVJCC does provide testing, however you will need to make an appointment and allow enough time for the results prior to entering the gym to play in scheduled game.*

Q: What do you mean by fully vaccinated?

A: *Fully vaccinated = Moderna (2 initial shots + 1 booster); Pfizer (2 initial shots + 1 booster); J&J (1 initial shot + 1 booster)*
